Welcome to the Eduardo Torroja Institute (IETcc-CSIC). Below are some practical tips to facilitate your visit.

Location and transport

The IETcc-CSIC is located at 4, Serrano Galvache St, Madrid. Common options to reach the venue:

- **Metro:**
Line 1 (Bambú station), about a 10–12 minute walk.
Line 9 (Duque de Pastrana or Pío XII stations), about 10-15 minute walk.
Line 4 (Manoteras station), about 15 minute walk).
- **Cercanías (local trains):**
Chamartín station, with multiple lines and direct access to bus routes.
- **EMT city buses:**
Lines 7, 29, 107 y 14 have nearby stops at Arturo Soria Av.
- **Taxi / Ride-hailing services:**
Drop-off is straightforward at the institute's main entrance.
- **Private vehicle:**
There is not availability to park within the premises.
